

How do I start windsurfing at the Cal Sailing Club?

1

Sign up for a membership! The Cal Sailing Club is a non-profit, volunteer-run windsurfing and sailing club located at the Berkeley Marina. All windsurfing and sailing lessons are included in your club membership, along with use of club gear!

2

Register for a lesson! We hold group Novice lessons every Saturday and Sunday morning. Lessons are taught by Cal Sailing Club members, and aim to give students as much on-the-water learning time as possible. Everything you need to get started is available to borrow, so be prepared to get wet!

3

Get your Novice rating! During the lesson, you'll get an orientation to the Cal Sailing Club, learn all of the basics about how to use the equipment safely and get out on the water. Students who can carry gear safely, demonstrate a 'self-rescue,' and pass the written test online will get their Novice rating at the end of the lesson.

4

Go windsurfing! Again! Once you have your Novice rating, you can check out equipment on your own whenever the club is open (7 days a week!). As of June 15, we have fully reopened and no longer have a reservation system in place. Hope to see you out on the water soon!
